What is INBENCH?

INBENCH, or the International Network Benchmarking Group, is a consortium of fixed-line telecoms operators formed in 1998 for the purpose of benchmarking various aspects of their activities. The last benchmarking round took place in 1999.

You can read about the history of INBENCH, and comments from Members.

From 2001, the entire benchmarking process will be carried out through a secure Web-based system. This will ensure efficient entry and validation of data and will allow members to view the anonymised results both as tables and charts. There are currently over 130 different unit cost, quality of service and utilisation metrics, ranging from IP packet loss to staff turnover.
